About the project

The Tauranga Eastern Link will be the largest state highway project ever built in the Bay of Plenty. It is being delivered by the NZ Transport Agency, with the design and construction by the Fulton Hogan HEB Construction Alliance.

Key features

- Four lanes, two in each direction
- Central median barrier
- New intersections for Mangatawa, Domain Road and Paengaroa junction (SH2/33)
- New overbridge for Parton Road and underpass for Maketu Road
- Urban design incorporating extensive landscaping.
- Electronic free-flow tolling system

- reduce travel times between Tauranga and Paengaroa
- lead to more efficient connections for business, industry and tourism
